



ARCH EUROPE ANNAHÜTTE, AUSTRIA

The Mountain Lodge that unites communities. In the tri-border region between Austria, Italy and Slovenia, the ruins of Annahütte, burnt down in WWI and WWII, have become a gathering place for people from all three countries to affirm their historic reconciliation.


ARCH EUROPE emphasizes the shared roots and values beneath the diverse traditions within European cultures, and supports initiatives that promote peace and commonality across borders.

After ISIS was defeated in Mosul, ARCH International embarked on the challenging mission to save one of the last surviving Biblical Shrines in this ancient region. The interfaith historic site has now been restored, and is open to visitors.
